## WHAT IS

## CLAIM THE WAVES?

Claim the Waves - the feminist radio days is a transnational 4-day networking meeting with participants involved in free radios from Switzerland, Germany and Austria. The aim is to jointly send out feminist waves and use radio as part of the feminist movements and self-empowerment.

The first Claim the Waves festival took place at Radio LoRa in Zurich in 2018. A network of motivated and courageous women, girls, lesbians, intersex, non-binary, and trans persons has been created there and should continue to grow.

Information about the network and the first Claim the Waves 2018 can be found on the website.

Every year, Claim the Waves is organized at a different radio station, and in 2020 the festival will be organized by ORANGE 94.0 - the free community radio in Vienna.

Input as to possible contents, proposals for workshop management and mobilization initiatives all come from inside the network. We will also try to implement the suggestions received by the participants of the previous festival.

We look forward to your participation, as well as numerous program and workshop contributions. You can find information about the individual calls in the text below. We are expecting up to 100 participants!

### Why feminist radio days & Why FLI\*NT Safe Spaces?

Women and queer persons are an important part of the free radio scene. Our media is a part of society, therefore, it's unfortunately not free from sexism and other forms of discrimination. For this reason, we are organizing these feminist radio days without men - in order to exchange ideas and to empower each other.

At Claim the Waves we want to create a safe(er) space in which we can treat each other with respect and care. We will not tolerate discriminatory and hurtful behavior.

We consider radio as a medium of a feminist space in which you can decide, try new things and become active against the Malestream. Your appearance doesn't matter on the radio, you don't have to speak loudly to make your voice heard, but of course you can.

In addition, the organizing team will support the self-organization of individual peer groups on site. There will be the possibility to create closed spaces for discussions and program production.

## Workshops

The impetus behind the workshop program should come from the participants themselves. An open workshop program with space for self-organized, spontaneous content is very important to us! In doing so, we want to create a space for mutual learning, promote exchange and encourage all to try out different radio formats. With this in mind, we are especially looking forward to your proposals regarding workshops.

We have defined three overarching topics as the framework for the planned workshops:

- **Radio & Technology**
- **Music**
- **Storytelling & Journalism**

Two workshop sessions with three to four workshops each will take place daily side by side. One workshop slot will be reserved for spontaneous ideas and self-organized on site, which do not have to fall under the three main topics. In addition to the workshops, there is an accompanying program consisting of city walks, a screen printing workshop, joint meals and a party on Saturday.

Aside from the regular workshop program, there will be a girls' channel with its own editorial staff.
